LEADER: "Good 6	evening and welcome to The Twelve Promises meeting of Overeaters Anonymous.
My name is	, I'm a compulsive eater, and your Leader for this meeting.
Please silence ver	ur alactronic davices, remain mutad unless speaking, and avoid visual distractions

Please silence your electronic devices, remain muted unless speaking, and avoid visual distractions that may disturb our meeting. Thank you!

At this meeting, we read the *Twelve Ninth Step Promises* and then share on the Promise of the week in a rotation. We encourage participation, via open discussion, in a loving and supportive manner."

(Screen Shares – Call on Volunteers to Read)

"Will someone please read the OA Preamble?"

"Will someone please read the *Twelve Steps*?"

"Will someone please read the Twelve Traditions?"

"Will someone please read the Twelve Promises?"

LEADER: "We will now pause for the Seventh Tradition and OA Announcements, if any.

Our Seventh Tradition states:

Every OA group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions.

While no dues or fees are required for membership, OA members have a responsibility to keep our rooms open, provide opportunities for fellowship, and spread our message of recovery.

Our Zoom Host will place Seventh Tradition Information into the chat."

"Are there any brief announcements for the good of OA?"

LEADER: (Announce the Promise for the meeting refer to the 12 Promises Schedule)
